



## General Information

#### REGISTRATION

Once again this year, students have the option to register by semester or for the full year. To enroll, please fill out the enclosed registration form, include proper payment and mail, fax or bring it to the Pittsburgh CLO Academy. Online registration is also available at pittsburghCLO.org.

#### PLACEMENT

The first two weeks of class are used for placement. If you are unsure of where to place your child, please contact 412-281-2234 for guidance.

#### TUITION PAYMENT

A minimum of the registration fee plus 25% of the total tuition must be paid at the time of registration. The remaining balance will be due according to the payment plan selected. To receive 5% off total tuition, payment must be made for the full 32-week school year (September to May) before August 31, 2009. Students whose accounts are past due will not be allowed to participate in class until the account is made current or payment arrangements are made.

#### WITHDRAWAL FROM CLASSES

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL MUST BE MADE IN WRITING.

Payments will be handled as follows:

Registration fee is non-refundable.

Withdrawal before the first class = no tuition payment due.

Withdrawal after the 1st week of classes = 50% of total tuition payment due.

Withdrawal after the 2nd week of classes = 100% of total tuition payment due.

#### DIRECTIONS

The CLO Academy is located on the 8th floor of Penn Avenue Place at 130 CLO Academy Way between Penn Avenue and Fort Duquesne Boulevard, across the street from Fifth Avenue Place. On weeknights after 4PM, students and parents can park at the ALCO parking garage at 6th and Penn (across from Heinz Hall) for \$3. Parking tickets are validated by the Academy's security guard.

#### PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons have special restrictions. Students will receive a private lesson contract upon acceptance into private instruction. All private voice and piano students who are enrolled in additional classes at the CLO Academy will receive a special discount of \$150 each semester on Voice and Piano. Call 412-281-2234 to schedule an audition or for more information.

- 2. Must call to schedule an audition day and time. Tel: 412-281-2234.
- 3. Upon completion of the audition, students will be told if they are accepted to participate in the Private Voice or Piano Program. If accepted at this time, the student must register and sign the Private Lesson Contract to receive an instructor, day and time.
