

\$20,000 SCHOLARSHIP

TECHNICAL THEATRE · STAGE MANAGEMENT

ELIGIBILITY

This scholarship is available for students who participate in the Pittsburgh CLO Gene Kelly Awards as a member of a participating high school. All candidates should be completing their senior year of high school and have applied and been academically accepted to Point Park University.

Each candidate is expected to also have submitted their materials, completed an interview and received artistic acceptance into Point Park University's School of Theatre, Film and Animation.

TERMS OF THE AWARD

The recipient of the scholarship must enroll as a full-time production major for the Fall term of 2026.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

This scholarship will be awarded in Technical Theatre and/or Stage Management. The award will be a four-year \$5,000 scholarship.

Students interested in being considered for either award should complete a Gene Kelly Scholarship application and submit it to Troy Centofanto, Director of Artistic Recruitment, Conservatory of Performing Arts by April 1, 2026.

Scholarship amount is valid only at Point Park University and has no cash value.
